

**ENVIRONMENT MONITORING UNIT FOR KEILOR
& FOR BRIMBANK COUNCIL REGION**

Air Services have adamantly decided that they will not have a sound monitoring unit in Keilor nor for that matter in Brimbank Council area. There will be one in East Keilor in someone's backyard which is near to the Ring Road and to the Railway Line, which can also interfere with the reliability of measurements. It will be at least 3 kms further away (as the crow flies) from where the monitoring unit used to be in Keilor Village.

The average reading at this new site for aircraft arriving or departing from Melbourne Airport is 70 decibels. Guess what in Keilor the sound levels can be 80 plus decibels. No wonder they want another site! The selected location is now within the Moonee Valley City Council region not Brimbank which is far more widely affected by aircraft activity.

Keep in mind the average number of flights now between 11pm and 6am is 50 flights and many of the departures from the 16 runway are at low levels and have excessive noise levels.

We want to have accurate measurements of aircraft noise in Keilor Village.
